END OF YEAR MESSAGE 2024

December 12, 2024

Catastrophic weather claimed the lives of hundreds of people in 2024 as increasingly severe natural disasters ripped across the world indiscriminately.

A rash of tornados pounded the United States in the spring while earthquakes and floods brought mass casualties to the Middle East, Asia and the Western Pacific. Summer heat waves were followed by an onslaught of hurricanes that disrupted life in the southeastern United States and a Category 5 super typhoon killed nearly 600 people across southeastern Asia. The year is on track to be the hottest on record, according to the World Meteorological Organization. For the first nine months of the year, the average temperature was more than 1.5 degrees Celsius above the pre-industrial level.

<u>Pastoral Visit</u>: On August 09, 2024, his eminence, the pastor and spiritual head of the Church, Pastor EMF Oshoffa was in USA for his annual Missionary journey. During the visit a number of harvest convocations were blessed, new church Cathedrals were dedicated and apostolic ministrations were administered. National Convention: The 7th USA Diocese National Convention – tagged "USA Restoration 2024 Convention" was successfully held on Thursday May 16 - May 19, 2024 at Indianapolis Marriott East Hotel. 7202 E 21ST Street, Indianapolis IN 46219. It was attended by 550 delegates and a total Contributions and donations of \$133,858 was realized against a total Overhead of \$130.987. The Convention was a mechanism instituted to address the challenges, both contemporary and otherwise, facing or plaguing the church with a view to engineering appropriate solutions. Thoroughly researched papers on Social Media, Women Empowerment, Membership beyond African in Diaspora, Re-defining the Evangelical Ministry, Youth Development and high Profile House-Keeping Imperatives were processed into blue-prints and filtered into the Diocese's Bye-Laws and Manual of Instruction after the Congress/Convention approval.

Parishes are required to implement all the Resolutions/Communique emanating from the Convention on or before April 30, 2025.

The next 2026 National Convention – tagged "USA National Convention of Ascension" is scheduled to hold on Thursday April 30 - May 03, 2026.
